### Antibiotic Use in Veterinary Dentistry

Amoxicillin/Clavulanate Some studies published in the Journal of Veterinary Dentistry indicated that amoxicillin/clavulanate was more effective (in vitro) than clindamycin against many oral pathogens. What happens on the culture plate may have little relationship to what happens in the mouth.

### Policy Statement: The Use of Antibiotics in Veterinary ...

In general, antibiotics are vastly over used in veterinary dentistry, often to the detriment of the patient. They are often used in an attempt to treat undiagnosed dental disease and this simply does not work. Consider how antibiotics work. If the drug is in high enough concentration around the bacteria, the drug either prevents bacterial reproduction (bacteriostatic) or actually kills the bacteria

Postoperative antibiotics are indicated when radiographic evidence of presumed osteomy- elitis is present. Clindamycin (5.5 mg/kg per os q 12 hr) and amoxicillin-clavulanic acid (13.75 mg/kg per os q 12 hr) are both approved for use in cases of dental infections and should be prescribed for a full 7 ~~7~~ • 4 day course.

Indications for antibiotic use. Antibiotics should only be used for oral infections where there is evidence of spreading infection ( cellulitis, lymph node involvement, swelling) or systemic involvement (fever, malaise), and where drainage or debridement is impossible. There are a limited number of localized oral lesions that are indicated for antibiotic use and these include periodontal abscess, acute necrotizing ulcerative gingivitis, and pericoronitis.
